## CHAPTER XVI.

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE ONE OF CHAPTER THIRTY-FOUR OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF THE STATE OF MINNE-SOTA, THE SAME BEING TITLE ONE OF CHAPTER SEV-ENTEEN OF STATUTES AT LARGE, RELATING TO CORPO-BATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That title one of chapter thirty-four of the general statutes of the state of Minnesota be and the same is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following new section:

Sec. 45. Any corporation heretofore or hereafter organized for the purpose of developing or improving the water power Rights of corpo-on any of the water courses of this state, and applying the rations organ-ized for the pursame to manufacturing purposes, and whose articles of asso-pose of develciation conform to the provisions of section three of this title, oping water may obtain the right to overflow, drain, or otherwise use, enjoy or damage, by reason of any dam, lock, sluice, waste gate or other erection necessary for the convenient prosecution of their enterprise, all or any lands, rights, easements or other property damaged thereby, by proceeding as in this title provided.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and When act to after its passage.

## CHAPTER XVII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THREE OF CHAPTER ELEVEN OF THE SESSION LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE, RELATING TO MANUFACTURING COR-PORATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesola:

SECTION 1. That section three of chapter eleven of the ses- Articles of assosion laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three be amended clatton, how by adding thereto the following words: Provided, That such

articles of association may be amended in any respect which might have been lawfully made a part of such original articles, at any meetings of such stockholders by a majority vote of all the shares of stock represented in such corporation, upon giving notice of a meeting of such stockholders, to be held for the purpose of making such change, in the same manner as provided in section four of this act for the first meeting of the corporation, except that notice of change shall not be waived as therein provided. Proof of the publication of such notice and change made by filing the affidavit of the publisher and a certified copy of the proceedings making such change, shall be filed in the office of the secretary of state in the same manner as provided for the filing of the articles of incorporation of such association therein.

## CHAPTER XVIII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TEN OF CHAPTER ELEVEN OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF MINNESOTA FOR EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE, RELATING TO MANUFACTURING CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Section ten of chapter eleven of the general laws of Minnesota is hereby amended so as to read as follows, viz.: A majority of the directors of every such corporation convened according to the by-laws, shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. And a majority of the stockholders present, or represented by proxy at any legal meeting, when a majority of the stock of such corporation is so represented at the meeting, shall be capable of transacting the business of that meeting; and at all meetings of such stockholders, each share shall entitle the holder thereof, or his representative, to one vote.

What to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

When act to take effect. SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
