

ceedings in the probate of a will," is hereby amended by adding thereto and at the end thereof the following words: And whenever by the terms of a will the person (or persons) therein named as executor or executrix is empowered to sell and convey real estate, an administrator with such will annexed, appointed to execute the same, shall have the same power to sell and convey real estate that the person (or persons) named therein as executor or executrix could have had in executing such will.

Power vested in administrator to sell and convey real estate.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LV.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE OF CHAPTER FIFTY-ONE OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

1875-60

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter fifty-one of the revised statutes of Minnesota be amended so as to read as follows: The widow, if any, shall be allowed all her articles of apparel and ornaments, and all the wearing apparel of the deceased; his household furniture, not exceeding in value five hundred dollars, and other personal property to be selected by her, not exceeding in value four hundred dollars; and this allowance shall be made as well when the widow receives the provisions made for her in the will of her husband, as when he dies intestate.

Personal estate, how distributed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.
