

CHAPTER XII.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CITY CHARTER OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section two of chapter one of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one be amended so as to read as follows :

Sec. 2. The following described territory in the county of Mower, in this state, shall constitute the city of Austin, viz : The north half of section numbered three, all of the south half of section numbered three lying west of the Cedar river, all that part of the southwest quarter of section number two, surveyed and platted as part of Balcom's addition to the village of Austin, the northwest quarter of section number two and the west half of the northeast quarter of section number two, all in township number one hundred and two, north of range eighteen west.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved March 5, 1875.

CHAPTER XIII.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF WINONA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section two of chapter one of the act entitled an act to amend the charter of the city of Winona, approved March first, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, [be] amended so that the proviso at the end of the first subdivision shall read as follows : *Provided*, The city council shall have the exclusive right to license persons vending, dealing in, or disposing of spirituous, vinous, fermented, mixed, or intoxicating liquors, within the limits of said city, and persons so licensed shall not be required to obtain a license from the board of county commissioners, and shall not be prosecuted for vending, dealing in, or disposing of spirituous, vinous, fermented, mixed, or intoxicating liquors, without first having obtained license therefor, agreeably to the provisions of chapter

sixteen of the general statutes, and that such license for so dealing in spirituous, vinous, fermented, mixed, or intoxicating liquors, shall be not less than ten nor more than one hundred dollars a year.

SEC. 2. Three-fourths of the money received from the licenses so granted shall be paid to the treasurer of the city of Winona, and one-fourth to the treasurer of the county of Winona.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved March 9, 1875.

CHAPTER XIV.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE VACATION OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF MANKATO.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the common council of the city of Mankato be, and it is hereby authorized and empowered, upon such terms and conditions as it may deem proper, to vacate the following streets in said city: All that portion of Winona street in West Mankato which lies between Eighth street and Blue Earth street; all or any portion of Spence street in said West Mankato, and also all of a certain street which lies between blocks twenty and twenty-one in Waite and Rolofson's addition to said city of Mankato.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XV.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MANKATO, APPROVED MARCH SIXTH, EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY- EIGHT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section nine of chapter three of said charter be amended so as to read as follows:
