

sixteen of the general statutes, and that such license for so dealing in spirituous, vinous, fermented, mixed, or intoxicating liquors, shall be not less than ten nor more than one hundred dollars a year.

SEC. 2. Three-fourths of the money received from the licenses so granted shall be paid to the treasurer of the city of Winona, and one-fourth to the treasurer of the county of Winona.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved March 9, 1875.

CHAPTER XIV.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE VACATION OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF MANKATO.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the common council of the city of Mankato be, and it is hereby authorized and empowered, upon such terms and conditions as it may deem proper, to vacate the following streets in said city: All that portion of Winona street in West Mankato which lies between Eighth street and Blue Earth street; all or any portion of Spence street in said West Mankato, and also all of a certain street which lies between blocks twenty and twenty-one in Waite and Rolofson's addition to said city of Mankato.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XV.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MANKATO, APPROVED MARCH SIXTH, EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY- EIGHT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section nine of chapter three of said charter be amended so as to read as follows:
