## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of two thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first moneys which shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund for the purpose of removing boulder from the channel of Long Prairie river, and making a few cuts in short bends from Long Prairie village, in Todd county, to Motley, on the Northern Pacific railroad, so this river can be used for the transportation of commodities by use of small steamboats and barges.

Sec. 2. That this appropriation shall be expended under the direction and supervision of Jacob Sarff, chairman of the county board of commissioners of Todd county, John Wait and Harkins, of

Todd county.

- Sec. 8. That the governor shall appoint three persons as a committee on the part of the state to view said improvements when made, and examine contracts, vouchers and accounts respecting all expenditures made, and make a report of said expenditures to the state auditor.
- SEC. 4. That upon receipt of said report by the state auditor, he shall draw his order in favor of said county of Todd, on the state treasurer, for any money belonging to the internal improvement fund to the amount of two thousand dollars, and the county treasurer of said county shall disburse said money upon the orders of the committee appointed by [the] governor, in payment of the cost of improve ing said river.

Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

## CHAPTER CXC.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO BUILD A BRIDGE ACROSS OKABENA CREEK, IN THE TOWN OF WEST HERON LAKE, IN JACKSON COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first moneys which shall come into the state treasury belonging to said fund, to build a substantial bridge across Okabena creek, at the point where said creek intersects the section

line between sections seven and eight, township one hundred and three, range thirty-seven, in town of West Heron Lake, being the point where the regularly laid out stage road between Heron Lake station, in said Jackson county, and Spirit Lake, Iowa, crosses said creek, and the said bridge, when erected, shall be kept in repair by the town of West Heron Lake, and be forever free from toll.

SEC. 2. The said bridge shall be built under the direction of the board of county commissioners of said Jackson county, and no part of said appropriation shall be paid of the state treasury until said

bridge shall be completed and ready for travel.

SEC. 3. The governor shall appoint three persons, citizens of Jackson county, to view said bridge when completed, and examine all contracts, vouchers and accounts respecting the construction and cost of said bridge, and fix the cost thereof, and make a report of said cost to the state auditor.

Sec. 4. That upon the receipt of said report by the state auditor, he shall draw his order in favor of said county of Jackson on the state treasurer, for the cost of the bridge, not to exceed the sum of five hundred dollars, and the state treasurer shall pay over such money to the county treasurer of Jackson county, upon said order of the state auditor, and such money shall be paid out by the county treasurer of Jackson county, upon the orders of said board of county commissioners, in payment of the cost of the said bridge.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

## CHAPTER CXCI.

AN ACT TO AID THE COUNTIES OF NOBLES AND ROCK TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO CONSTRUCT BRIDGES AND OPEN AND IMPROVE THE ROAD FROM WORTHINGTON, IN NOBLES COUNTY, VIA LUVERNE, TO THE WEST LINE OF ROCK COUNTY, ON THE WORTHINGTON, LUVERNE AND SIOUX FALLS ROAD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first money which may come into the treasury belonging to said fund, to construct bridges and open and improve the road from Worthington, in Nobles county, via Luverne, to the west line of Rock county, on the Worthington, Luverne and Sioux Falls road, as at present located.

SEC. 2. That said bridges shall be constructed and said road
