## CHAPTER LXXIII.

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER EIGHTY-NINE OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE, ENTITLED AN ACT TO REGULATE CLERK HIRE IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF CARVER COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Chapter eighty-nine of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, entitled "An act to regulate clerk hire in the office of the county auditor of Carver county," is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

## CHAPTER LXXIV.

AN ACT TO MAKE PAUPERS A TOWN CHARGE IN FREEBORN COUNTY.

Be it enacted by he Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Each township in the county of Freeborn, in this state, shall take care of and bear the expense of its own poor or paupers, in the same way and manner, so far as applicable, as is now provided

for counties to take care of its poor or paupers.

Sec. 2. All applications for aid shall be made to the board of township supervisors, under oath of two creditable persons, and upon a proper case being made out for aid to care for a poor person or pauper, the supervisors, or majority of them, shall order such sum of money or other thing as they deem best to be paid to such poor person or pauper, at such time and manner as may be deemed necessary.

Sec. 3. The county treasurer of said county shall refund to the town treasurer of each township the amount of poor fund in his hands, or that may come into his hands belonging to each town or

collected from each town.

Sec. 4. The general laws of this state as to residence of poor persons in order to obtain aid from counties, shall apply to townships
