CHAPTER LXXVIII.

AN ACT TO ADD CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE COUNTY SEAT OF ROCK COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the southwest quarter of section eleven, town one hundred and two, range forty-five, in Rock county, heretofore only platted and laid out as in addition to the village plat of Luverne, in said county and state, be and the same is hereby declared to constitute a part and parcel of said original plat of Luverne, the same in all respects as if the same was originally platted as a part of said village plat of Luverne. And any and all county or other public buildings authorized to be erected on said village plat of Luverne as originally platted, may be erected on said addition in same manner as if it originally constituted and was platted with said original town, and was part and parcel of the same.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER LXXIX.

AN ACT TO VACATE THE PLAT OF A PIECE OR TRACT OF UN-OCCUPIED LAND, LAID OUT AND PLATTED INTO VILLAGE LOTS AS AN ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF ALBERT LEA, THE PLAT OF SAID ADDITION HAVING BEEN LOST AND NEVER RE-COVERED.

Be it enacted by he Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all lots, streets and alleys, situate on that tract or piece of ground on the west end of lot one, in section nine, in township one hundred and two, north of range twenty-one west, lying west of the centre of Shell Rock river, and south of the Southern Minnesota railroad track, in said section be, and the same are hereby vacated, and said land is restored to the same condition as though said land had never been platted or laid out as an addition to the village of Albert Lea, in Freeborn county.
