Mathias Seibenaler against Charles A. Baker, for a seat in the house of representatives for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-six, from the 20th senatorial district, composed of the county of Dakota.

Whenact to take SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXIV.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF IN-TEREST ON STATE LOADS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation SECTION I. That the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars, be for state interest, and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the state interest fund, to be expendented as the state in payment of interest on state indebtedness.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.

CHAPTER CXV.

· AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation for certain purposes. SECTION 1. That the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated:

1st.—For amount due judges on salaries of eighteen hundred and seventy-five, two thousand five hundred and ninty-six and

sixty-four one hundredths dollars (\$2,596.64).

2d.—For amount due engineer, night watchman and fireman, for services in eighteen hundred and seventy-five, one hundred and fifty-eight dollars (\$158).
