CHAPTER V.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 130 AND 144 OF CHAPTER ONE OF GENERAL LAWS OF 1874, RELATING TO TAXES.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. Section 144 of chapter one of the general laws of 1874, as amended by section 41 of chapter five of the general laws of 1875, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Sec. 144." Any person who has a lien by mortgage or otherwise, upon any land, on which the taxes have not been paid, may pay such taxes and the interest, penalty and charges due thereon, and the receipt of the person authorized to receive such tax shall constitute an additional lien on such land to the amount therein specified and the interest thereon, and the amount so paid with interest thereon at the rate of twelve per cent. per annum shall be collectable as a part of, and in the same manner, as the amount secured by the original lien. <sup>Persons having lien upon land may pay taxes, &c., such payments to be additional lien.</sup>

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. <sup>When act to take effect.</sup>

CHAPTER VI.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION OF TAXES IN UNORGANIZED COUNTIES.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That hereafter taxes shall be levied and collected in all unorganized counties in this state by the counties to which.

they may be attached for judicial and record purposes, only for state purposes, for the payment of the principal and interest of any legal indebtedness of such unorganized counties and a reasonable sum per annum as compensation for the county to which such unorganized counties are attached; *Provided*, That such annual compensation for the levy and collection of taxes and for all other expenses, shall not exceed the aggregate sum of ten (10) mills per acre of land subject to taxation in such unorganized counties the amount of said compensation to be extended uniformly upon the taxable property of such counties according to the assessed valuation thereof.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER VII.

### AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 26 OF CHAPTER 1 OF THE SESSION LAWS OF 1875, RELATING TO TAXES.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That section 112 of chapter one (1) of the general laws of A. D. 1874, as amended by section 26 of chapter five (5) of the general laws of 1875 be amended by adding thereto the following proviso—

Non-exclusion of papers printed partly in foreign languages.

“*Provided*, that this section shall not be so construed as to exclude newspapers which are printed partly in the English language and partly in some foreign language, if the amount so printed in a foreign language does not exceed one-fourth of the printed matter in said newspaper. *And provided, further*; that said list shall be published in the English language.”

List to be printed in English.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
