

CHAPTER LXII.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 79, OF THE GENERAL LAWS
OF 1873.*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter 79 of the general laws of 1873, be amended so as to read as follows :

Terms of court in
certain counties.

Sec. 2. That the general terms of the district court of the ninth judicial district shall be held in the several counties in said district at the times hereinafter prescribed, to-wit :

Lyon.

In the county of Lyon, on the second Tuesday in June in each year.

Nicollet.

In the county of Nicollet, on the fourth Tuesday in May, and on the second Tuesday in December, in each year.

Brown.

In the county of Brown, on the first Tuesday in May, and on the third Tuesday in November, in each year.

Redwood.

In the county of Redwood, on the third Tuesday in June in each year.

Renville.

In the county of Renville, on the third Tuesday in September in each year.

Relating to said
terms.

Sec. 3. All writs, recognizances, and other papers and proceedings made returnable to the district court of the several counties constituting the ninth judicial district shall be considered and be deemed to be returnable to the terms of said court, as the same are fixed by this act, and all continuances, appeals, motions, notices, or other proceedings taken or made to or for any term of said court shall be considered and construed to be made or taken to the terms of said court as fixed by this act.
