CHAPTER CLXXIV.

AN ACT TO VACATE THE VILLAGE PLAT OF SAINT NICHOLAS, IN FREEBORN COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the plat of the village of Saint Nicholas, in the county of Freeborn, state of Minnesota, comprising the following territory, to wit.: Lot number four, in section twenty-five, and lots one (1), two (2) and three (3), and the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter, of section twenty-six (26), all in township one hundred and two (102) north, of range twenty-one west of the fifth principal meridian, according to the United States survey, be and the same is hereby declared vacated, and the streets, alleys and public grounds thereon declared closed to public use.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CLXXV.

AN ACT TO VACATE A PART OF ST. CLAIR'S TERRE HAUTE ADDI-TION TO CANNON FALLS, IN THE COUNTY OF GOODHUE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That all that part of the plat of "St. Clair's Terre Haute Addition," to the village of Cannon Falls, in the county of Goodhue, according to the plat thereof in the office of the register of deeds of said county, lying east of Fourth street, be and the same hereby is vacated, and the lands covered by that part of said plat shall hereafter be assessed for taxation as lands, and not as village lots." *Provided*, That all taxes heretofore levied or assessed upon any lots lying within that part of said plat hereby lvacated, shall be collected in the same manner as though this act had not been passed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
