

## CHAPTER LXXXIX.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO OF CHAPTER 107, OF SPECIAL LAWS OF A. D. 1875, RELATING TO GOSHEN SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE COUNTIES OF BLUE EARTH AND BROWN,

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That section two of chapter 107 of the special laws of the year A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy-five, be so amended as to read as follows :

Sec. 2. Said Goshen school district, for all school purposes, shall be a school district corporation of Brown county, and all taxes hereafter voted in the district for school purposes, shall be reported by the clerk of the district to the county auditors of Blue Earth and Brown counties, on or before the tenth day of October in each year. The said auditors shall thereupon transmit, each to the other, an abstract of the assessment in that part of the district in their respective counties, and shall levy the amount required in proportion to the amount of property in that part of the district situated in their respective counties. The money arising from such assessment shall be drawn by the district treasurer from the county treasurer of each county in which the district is situated. The number of scholars in the district shall be returned to the superintendent of schools of Brown county, and all public school funds for said district shall be apportioned to Brown county, and drawn by the district in the same manner as when the district is in one county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XC.

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE AND CREATE A SCHOOL DISTRICT OUT OF CERTAIN TERRITORY LYING IN LE SUEUR AND SCOTT COUNTIES.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the north half, and the southwest quarter of section one, and the east half of the northwest quarter, and the east half of section two, and the east half of the southwest quarter of section

eleven, and the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter, and the east half of section fourteen, and section thirteen, all being in township number one hundred and twelve (112) of range number twenty-four (24) west, and in the county of LeSueur, and sections thirty-five, and thirty-six, and the west half of the southeast quarter of section twenty-five, and the south half of the southeast quarter, and the southwest quarter of section twenty-six, and the southeast quarter of section thirty-four, all in township number one hundred and thirteen (113), of range number twenty-four (24), in the county of Scott. be and the same, and every part of the foregoing territory, is hereby set off and created into, and declared to be, a special school district under the name and style of "Union school district," and as such school district, under the name and style aforesaid, to have and enjoy all the powers and rights and be subject to all the duties of a common school district organized under the general laws of this state.

SEC. 2. The legal voters who are free holders within said "Union school district," within sixty days after the passage of this act shall meet at the school house, at the northwest corner of the northwest quarter of said section one, and elect a director, treasurer, and clerk of said district and the said officers so elected shall immediately qualify, and the clerk shall thereupon and at once notify the proper officers of the said counties of LeSueur and Scott, of the said election; provided a notice of the time and place of said meeting signed by any five of the legal voters and free holders aforesaid shall be given in the manner provided by law.

SEC. 3. Whenever any officers are elected or taxes are voted by said district, the clerk thereof shall report the same to the proper officers of each of said counties, and such taxes shall be levied upon the property, and collected by the officers of each of said counties in the same manner as other taxes are collected and levied; and the same, together with all other moneys due said district, shall be paid over to the treasurer of said district, and any taxes now levied upon property in said district shall, when collected, be paid to said treasurer.

SEC. 4. The county superintendent of said county of Le Sueur, shall have jurisdiction over said district, and visit the same, and grant certificates to teach therein as in other cases.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
