

CHAPTER 120.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS TWENTY-EIGHT (28) AND THIRTY-TWO (32) OF TITLE THREE (3) OF CHAPTER NINETEEN (19), GENERAL STATUTES ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO DISTRAINING BEASTS FROM DOING DAMAGE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section twenty-eight (28) of title three (3) of chapter nineteen (19), general statutes one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be amended by inserting after the word "town" in the seventh (7th) line of said section the words "or of any near justice of the peace in any adjoining town or city within the same county."

Addenda.

SEC. 2. That section thirty-two (32) of said title and chapter be amended by inserting after the word "town" in the fifth (5th) line of said section the words "or in the nearest pound in any adjoining town or city within the same county."

Cattle may be impounded in any adjoining town.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 121.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SIXTEEN (16) OF CHAPTER THIRTY-SIX (36) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the second (2d) proviso of section sixteen (16), chapter thirty-six (36), general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
