

installments, and no treasurer receiving pay for his services under said second proviso, whose salary cannot be certainly and exactly fixed at the beginning of his official year, shall receive more than one-twelfth of his annual salary at the end of each month as carefully estimated and recorded by the board of county commissioners at their January meeting in each year, and the balance of the year's pay found to be legally due the treasurer shall be paid him on the computation of said board of commissioners at their next January meeting.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of January, A. D., one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six (1886). When act to take effect.

CHAPTER 17.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THREE (3), TITLE THREE (3), CHAPTER SEVEN (7), GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO SALARIES OF COUNTY ATTORNEYS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section three (3) of title three (3) of chapter seven (7), general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be, and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words "twelve hundred" in the second line of said section three (3) and insert in lieu thereof the words "two thousand." Increase of salary.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
