## CHAPTER 247.

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE HUGH J. BYRNE FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN CONTESTED ELECTION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of one thousand (1,000) dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to Hugh J. Byrne out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse him for moneys expended · in the contested election case of Anton Rochek against Hugh J. Byrne, for a seat in the house of representatives for A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885).

## CHAPTER 248.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PURCHASE SAFE FOR THE FIFTH (5TH) DISTRICT OF THE SURVEYOR GENERAL OF LOGS AND LUMBER AT DULUTH, MINN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) For what purbe, and the same is hereby, appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of purchasing a suitable fireproof safe for the protection of books and papers in the office of the surveyor general of logs and lumber of the fifth (5th) district at Duluth, Minnesota.

SEC. 2. That L. Merritt, the present surveyor general By whom to be of said district, is hereby appointed in behalf of the state to purchase such safe as in his judgment the necessities of the aforesaid office requires, and make report of expense of same to the state auditor.
