Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That the sum of two hundred (200) dollars be, and is hereby, appropriated as a reward for said arrest and conviction to said James W. Hankinson out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, and that a warrant issue pursuant to law for said sum, payable to said Hankinson or order.

For what purpose money appropriated.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.

CHAPTER 250.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE CERTAIN MONEYS TO PAY THE SALARIES AND EXPENSES PROVIDED FOR AND INCURRED UNDER AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO REGULATE WARE-HOUSES, INSPECTION, WEIGHING AND HANDLING OF GRAIN."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That all moneys paid into the state treasury for, on account of, or by reason of any of the provisions of an act of the legislature entitled "An act to regulate warehouses, inspection, weighing and handling of grain" (or so much thereof as may be necessary), be and the same hereby are annually appropriated for the purpose of paying the salaries, fees and expenses provided for in and contemplated by said act.

Fees, salaries

This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to and after its passage.
