CHAPTER 251.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE ERECTION OF MEMORIAL TABLETS ON THE BATTLEFIELD OF GETTYSBURG.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Battlefield of Gettysburg monument appropriation for. SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be expended in the erection of memorial tablets to mark the position of the First Regiment, Minnesota Volunteers on the battlefield of Gettysburg, which said sum shall be disbursed by the Gettysburg Battlefield Memorial Association, in such manner as the governor of this state shall consent to and approve.

Warrant — by whom drawn, SEC. 2. The money hereby appropriated shall be drawn from the state treasury by the governor upon his warrant therefor.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 252.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE USE OF THE STATE BOARD OF IMMIGRATION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

State board of emigration appropriation for. SECTION 1. That the sums of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per year, respectively, for the years one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), and one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six (1886) be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the use of the state board of immigration, to be expended as provided in chapter seventy-six (76) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879), and in acts amendatory thereto, being chapter thirty-four (34) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881) and chapter
