Term of office.

Sec. 224. There shall be chosen in each organized county one person, who shall be called a court commissioner and hold his office for the term of four (4) years and until his successor is elected and qualified.

Extension of term of office.

SEC. 2. The term of all court commissioners elected at the general election in November, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four (1884), shall extend to the first (1st) Monday of January, one thousand eight hundred and eightynine (1889), and until their successors are elected and qualified.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THIRTY-EIGHT (38), CHAPTER ONE (1), GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO FEES OF MESSENGERS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section thirty-eight (38) of chapter one (1) of general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following words: The county auditor shall, upon the receipt of said returns, draw a warrant on the county treasurer in favor of said messenger for the amount found to be due him for carrying said returns.

Fees, how paid.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
