May tenth (10th), one thousand eight hundred and eightyone (1881), signed by the county treasurer of Scott county, and the receipt forsaid money dated November fourth (4th), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), signed by the state treasurer, the said state anditor shall draw his warrant upon the state treasurer for said sum in favor of said Frederick Molkenberg, which warrant, upon presentation shall be paid out of the general revenue fund of said state.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 289.

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTIES OF HENNEPIN, WASHINGTON, DAKOTA, RAMSEY AND WINONA, FOR BOARDING STATE PRISON CONVICTS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of seventeen hundred and fifty-one (1751) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of reimbursing the counties of Hennepin, Washington, Dakota, Ramsey and Winona for boarding state prison convicts during the time that the state prison was unfit for use on account of fire in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four (1884).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
