## CHAPTER 172.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COLLECTING THE LAWS, ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS IN FORCE AFFECTING THE VILLAGE OF PRESTON; MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The village council of the village of Preston, Minnesota, is hereby authorized to have collected and published, as often as [may be] deemed advisable, the incorporating act and the acts amendatory thereof, together with other laws in force affecting said village, also all ordinances, rules and regulations adopted and in force for the government of said village, and to publish the same in pamphlet or other form, as the council may prescribe.

SEC. 2. The publication authorized by this act, and purporting therein to have been directed by the village council, of which the certificate thereof by the mayor, attested by the recorder, printed therewith, shall be evidence, and shall be received in evidence in the courts in this state without further proof, of the laws, ordinances, rules and regulations embraced therein, until it shall appear that

repeal or amendment thereof has been made.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
