CHAPTER 178.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HENNEPIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO BUILD A BRIDGE ACROSS THE CHANNEL WHERE WAYZATA BAY EMPTIES INTO GRAY'S OR OUTLET LAKE, ON LAKE MINNETONKA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the county commissioners of Hennepin county, state of Minnesota, are hereby authorized and empowered to cause to be constructed and put in suitable condition for travel, a wagon bridge across the channel where Wayzata bay empties into Gray's or Outlet lake, on Lake Minnetonka, in said Hennepin county; Provided, That the cost of said bridge shall not exceed the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000). The sum of money required to construct said bridge, not exceeding the sum above stated, to be paid out of the treasury of Hennepin county, from any moneys not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
