

CHAPTER 191.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE RED RIVER WATER POWER COMPANY TO ERECT A DAM ACROSS THE OTTER TAIL RIVER AT BRECKENRIDGE, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for the Red River Water Power company of Breckenridge, Minnesota, to erect a dam across the Otter Tail river on section eleven (11), township one hundred and thirty-two (132) north, of range forty-seven (47) west, and to construct a canal or flume from thence to the Bois des Sioux river at or near the town of Breckenridge, in or through which the said water power company may draw so much of the water from said Otter Tail river as it may require for milling and manufacturing purposes and supplying water for the towns of Breckenridge, Minnesota, and Wahpeton, Dakota.

SEC. 2. The said water power company shall have the same rights and privileges as to flowage, and be liable to the same damages, as is provided in chapter thirty-one (31) of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), and all the provisions of said chapter shall apply to said portion of said river as fully in all respects as though said river was not navigable; *Provided*, That sections two (2) and three (3) of chapter thirty-two (32) of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) shall also apply to said portion of said river.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
