

CHAPTER 192.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LOWERING OF THE WATERS OF A CERTAIN LAKE IN WRIGHT COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Seymore Smith, Homer Markham and William Shaw, of Wright county, Minnesota, be authorized and empowered to drain the lands surrounding that certain lake in Wright county, situated and known as Rice lake, situated in sections seven (7) and eighteen (18), town one hundred and twenty-two (122), range twenty-six (26), and to lower the waters of said lake not to exceed five (5) feet below the low water mark; *Provided*, That they in all things comply with the provisions of the laws of this state relating to drainage of wet lands, marshes and swamps.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 193.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LOWERING OF THE WATERS OF A CERTAIN LAKE IN WRIGHT COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That those persons who own lands upon the shores of "Lake Mary," situate on section five (5), in town one hundred and nineteen (119), and on section thirty-two (32), town one hundred and twenty (120), both of range twenty-five (25), in the county of Wright, are hereby permitted to lower the outlet of said lake, not to exceed two (2) feet; *Provided*, That all persons effected by such drainage consent thereto, and file such consent in writing in the office of the register of deeds in and for said Wright county.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
