

**CHAPTER 218.**

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE CERTAIN ROADS IN ANOKA COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That all proceedings heretofore had by the county commissioners of Anoka county in laying out and establishing county roads in said county are hereby legalized and declared to be valid, and such county roads are declared to be legally established highways of said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

**CHAPTER 219.**

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF ST. PAUL IN EXECUTING A CERTAIN DEED.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That that certain deed, dated the nineteenth (19th) day of September, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), and executed by the board of education of the city of St. Paul, Ramsey county, Minnesota, as grantor, and signed and acknowledged for and in behalf of said board of education by Chas. D. Kerr as president, and J. G. Donnelly as secretary, of said board of education, to Gilman G. Stilson as grantee, whereby the following piece of land situated in the county of Ramsey and state of Minnesota, and described as lots fourteen (14) and fifteen (15), in block fifty-four (54) of West St. Paul, proper, according to the recorded plat thereof, on file in the office of the register of deeds of said Ramsey county, and recorded in book one hundred and three (103) of deeds, on page twenty-nine (29) and thirty (30), in the office of the register of deeds of said Ramsey

county, be and the same are hereby legalized and made valid in all respects, and the acts of said board of education in selling said property and causing its said officers to execute said deed, are hereby legalized and made valid in all respects.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 220.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACTION OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER ONE (1) OF THE COUNTY OF MILLE LACS IN VOTING TO ISSUE ITS BONDS TO BUILD A NEW SCHOOL HOUSE, AND THE PROCEEDINGS HAD IN REFERENCE THERETO.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the action of the voters of school district number one (1) of Mille Lacs county, Minnesota, at a special school meeting held therein on the fifth (5th) day of July, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four (1884), whereby the said district voted to raise a tax of two thousand (2,000) dollars by issuing bonds for the purpose of building a new school building in said district; be and the same is hereby legalized and confirmed.

SEC. 2. That the actions of said school district in levying the taxes, issuing the bonds and letting the contract for building the said new school house, in pursuance thereof, be and the same are hereby legalized and confirmed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
