

## CHAPTER 237.

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SEVEN (337) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE (1879), AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS FOR DAKOTA COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That chapter three hundred [and] thirty-seven (337) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred [and] seventy-nine (1879), entitled "An act to abolish the office of county superintendent of schools of Dakota county, and merge the duties heretofore performed by said superintendent of schools with that of probate judge of said county," be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the state high school board, upon the passage of this bill or as soon thereafter as practicable, to appoint a county superintendent of schools for the county of Dakota, who shall enter upon the duties of the office within ten (10) days after receiving official notice of his appointment, and who shall hold said office until the first (1st) Monday in January A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), and until his successor is appointed and qualified.

SEC. 3. It shall be the duty of the state high school board, on or before the first (1st) Monday of December, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six (1886) and bi-ennially thereafter, to appoint a county superintendent of schools for said Dakota county, who shall enter upon his duties the first (1st) Monday of January succeeding his appointment and hold his office for two (2) years and until his successor is appointed and qualified; *Provided*, That each superintendent so appointed shall at the time of entering upon the duties of his office, hold a state certificate of scholarship and professional knowledge, issued by the state examining committee or by the state high school board.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
