

CHAPTER 252.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE COMPENSATION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF POLK COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of Polk shall each receive three (3) dollars per day for each day necessarily employed as the county board of said county, not to exceed thirty (30) days in any one year, and ten (10) cents per mile for every mile traveled in going to and returning from the meetings of the county board in the discharge of official duty; the mileage so traveled to be computed by the nearest traveled route; *Provided*, That in addition to the compensation above provided for, any county commissioner, while actually and necessarily employed in the business of the county aside from the sessions of the county board, may charge and receive pay at the rate of three (3) dollars per day for each day so employed, and ten (10) cents per mile for every mile traveled in the performance of such duty, but no county commissioner shall as such, receive more than two hundred and fifty (250) dollars in any one year for mileage and services, extra or otherwise.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
