

## CHAPTER 253.

AN ACT RELATING TO SALARY AND COMPENSATION OF THE TREASURER OF CLAY COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The treasurer of Clay county shall be paid a salary of eight hundred (\$800) dollars per annum, commencing January first (1st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), in addition to all fees and compensation now allowed by law. Said salary to be payable monthly.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 254.

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE SALARY, COMPENSATION AND FEES OF CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS OF POLK COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The annual salary of the county auditor of said Polk county shall be two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for his personal services, in addition to which he shall be allowed for clerk hire a sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500) in any one year.

SEC. 2. The annual salary of the county treasurer of said Polk county shall be eighteen hundred dollars (\$1,800) for his personal services, in addition to which he shall be allowed for clerk hire a sum not exceeding seven hundred dollars (\$700) in any one year.

SEC. 3. The fees of the register of deeds shall be as now fixed by law; *Provided*, That all fees collected or received by him over and above thirty-five hundred dollars (\$3,500) in any one year, in performing
