

## CHAPTER 258.

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF STEARNS COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the terms of the offices of the county commissioners of Stearns county shall be as follows: The commissioners of the first (1st), fourth (4th) and fifth (5th) districts shall hold their respective offices until the first (1st) day of January, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), and until their successors are elected and qualified; the commissioners of the second (2d) and third (3d) districts shall hold their offices until the first (1st) day of January, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889), and until their successors are elected and qualified. And hereafter when any commissioner is elected for said county he shall be elected for four (4) years.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 259.

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE CATCHING OF FISH IN OSAKIS LAKE, SITUATE IN DOUGLAS AND TODD COUNTIES, AND TO PREVENT SHIPMENT OF FISH CAUGHT IN SAID LAKE.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to take, catch or kill any kind of fish in lake Osakis, situate in the counties of Douglas and Todd, or in any waters running into said Osakis lake, from the fifteenth (15th) day of March to the fifteenth (15th) day of May in any year.

SEC. 2. That no person shall export or ship from the railroad depot at Osakis, in said Douglas county, fish of any kind taken from the waters of said Osakis lake or the waters running into said lake.
