

CHAPTER 311.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS TO APPROPRIATE MONEYS OUT OF ITS CURRENT EXPENSES FUND, FOR CONSTRUCTING CERTAIN ROADS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. The city council of the city of Minneapolis is hereby authorized to appropriate out of its fund devoted to the current expenses of said city the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000), for the purpose of constructing a good road across the low grounds extending from near the centre of section thirteen (13), in township twenty-nine (29), range twenty-four (24), in the first (1st) ward of said city, along Broadway street, or where the same shall be extended east to the east limit of said city. Said city council is also hereby authorized to appropriate out of said current expense fund the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), or so much thereof as they may deem necessary, for the purpose of constructing a good road from some point in said city to the city limits, to connect said city with some road leading to the state fair grounds in the county of Ramsey, said road to be built along such line as said city council shall deem most feasible.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
