

**CHAPTER 42.**

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1) OF CHAPTER THREE (3) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), BEING "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF AUDUBON, IN THE COUNTY OF BECKER AND STATE OF MINNESOTA."

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter three (3) of the special laws of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881) be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1. That the following described territory in the county of Becker, state of Minnesota, to-wit: the east half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the southeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section nine (9), the southwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section ten (10), and lots numbered one (1), two (2) and three (3) of the northwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section fifteen (15), all in township number one hundred and thirty-nine (139) north, of range number forty-two (42) west, be and the same is hereby set apart for incorporation, and the same is hereby incorporated, under the corporate name and style of the village of Audubon, to be organized pursuant to chapter one hundred and thirty-nine (139) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five (1875) and the amendments thereto.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
