SEC. 3. The voters at any such election voting in favor of the approval of such resolution and the issuing of such bonds shall use printed or written, or partly printed and partly written, ballots, which shall read as follows: "For the approval of the resolution of the board of trustees authorizing the issue and sale of the bonds of the village of Two Harbors, in the sum of ..... the construction of water works in said village — Yes:" and those voting against the approval of such resolution and the issuing of such bonds shall use printed or written, or partly printed and partly written, ballots, which shall read as follows: "For the approval of the resolution of the board of trustees authorizing the issue and sale of bonds of the village of Two Harbors, in the sum of ...... for the construction of water works in said village-No." If a majority of the votes cast at any such election shall be in favor of the approval of such resolution and the issuing of such bonds, then said board of trustees may issue such bonds, in the amount and upon the terms and conditions in such resolution specified. majority of such votes shall be against such approval and issuing such bonds, then said board of trustees shall not issue such bonds; Provided, however, that if a majority of such votes shall be against the approval of such resolution and the issuing of such bonds, the same, or another, resolution authorizing the issue of the bonds for the purpose herein specified, may at any time after the expiration of six (6) months be again submitted to a vote of the legal voters of said village in the manner herein provided.

SEC. 4. The board of trustees of said village shall make provisions, by the levying of taxes, for the payment of such bonds and interest as

they shall mature.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 104.

[H. F. No. 44.]

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF THE VILLAGE ELECTION OF THE VILLAGE OF VESELI, IN THE COUNTY OF RICE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the annual election of village officers of the village of Veseli, in the county of Rice, shall hereafter be held on the second (2d) Tuesday of April of each year, instead of second (2d) Tuesday of March.

SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts, so far as inconsistent herewith,

be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
