CHAPTER 194.

Notaries public, fees An act to amend section No. 5557 of the General Statutes of 1894, relating to fees of notary public.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Sec. 5557, G. S. 1894, amended. SECTION 1. That section 5557 of the General Statutes of 1894 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Schedule of fees.

"For drawing and copy of protest of the non-payment of a promissory note, or bill of exchange, or of the nonacceptance of such a bill, one (1) dollar in the cases where by law said protest is necessary.

For drawing and a copy of every other protest, twenty-

five (25) cents.

For drawing copy and serving every notice of non-payment of note, or non-acceptance of a bill, twenty-five (25) cents.

Drawing any affidavit or other paper or proceeding, for which provisions is not herein made, twenty (20) cents for each folio, and copying the same, six (6) cents for each folio.

For each oath administered, twenty-five (25) cents.

Taking the acknowledgment of deeds and for other services authorized by law the same fees as are allowed to other officers for similar services.

Recording each instrument required by law to be re-

corded by him, ten (10) cents per folio."

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 195.

Notaries public. An act to legalize certain acknowledgments, taken by officers, directors, or stockholders of corporations, as notaries public, of instruments in which the corporation was interested.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Acknowledgments by, of corporation of which notary is an officer legalized. Section 1. That all acknowledgments taken between the twenty-sixth (26th) day of February and the twentieth (20th) day of March in the year one thousand eight
