Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section one (1) of chapter one hundred and eighty-one (181) of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for eighteen hundred and ninety-five (1895) be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 1, c. 181, Laws of 1895. amended.

"Section 1. The teacher's university certificate issued by the University of Minnesota to graduates of the department of pedagogy in said university shall be valid as a certificate of the first grade to teach in the public schools of the State of Minnesota for a period of two (2) years from its date."

Certificates valid for two year.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That all acknowledgements heretofore taken by a notary public who was also an officer, director or stockholder of a corporation organized under the laws of this state, or organized without the state, which corporation was interested as a party to, in the instrument acknowledged, are hereby legalized, and made as effectual as if the notary public had not been an officer, director or stockholder of the corporation interested.

SEC. 2. The provisions of this act shall not affect any action now pending.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
