## CHAPTER 36.

Arbor day.

*An act authorizing the governor to designate a day to be known as Arbor and Bird Day.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

To be set  
apart by gov-  
ernor; how  
observed.

SECTION 1. The governor is hereby authorized to set apart each year by proclamation one day to be designated as Arbor and Bird Day, and to request its observance by all public schools, private schools, colleges and other institutions, by the planting of trees and the adornment of the school and public grounds and by suitable exercises, having for their object the advancement of the study of arboriculture and promotion of the spirit of protection to birds and trees and the cultivation of an appreciative sentiment concerning them.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 37.

Foreclosure by advertisement.

*An act to amend section 13 of chapter 53 of the general laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1878, entitled, "An act providing for the foreclosure of mortgages on real estate by advertisement;" said section 13 being section 6041 of the general statutes, 1894.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section 13 of chapter 53 of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1878, entitled, "An act providing for the foreclosure of mortgages on real estate by advertisement," and being section 6041 of the General Statutes of 1894, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Redemption,  
when and how  
made.

"Sec. 13. The mortgagor, his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns, whose real property is sold in conformity to the provisions of this act, may, within twelve months after such sale, redeem such property as hereinafter provided by paying the sum of money for which the same was sold, together with interest on the same from the time of such sale. *Provided*, that no redemption shall be made for real property sold in conformity to the provisions of this act, when the mortgage
