

CHAPTER 98.

H. F. No. 204.

An act to provide punishment for illegal voting at school meetings.

Illegal voting
at school
meetings.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Whoever not being a qualified voter, and not entitled to vote at a school meeting, held in any school district, shall with unlawful intent vote at any such school meeting, or on any question, or for the election of any officer to be elected at such school meeting, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed one hundred (100) dollars, or imprisonment in the county jail for not exceeding three months.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 99.

H. F. No. 221.

An act to amend section sixty-eight hundred fifty-seven (6857), General Statutes eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894), relating to the getting on and off moving cars or engines.

Cars and
engines.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section sixty-eight hundred and fifty-seven (6857), General Statutes eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 6857,
G. S. 1894,
amended.

It shall be unlawful for any person, other than passengers or employes, to get on or off, or attempt to get on or off, or to swing on or hang on from the outside of, any engine or car or any electric motor or street car upon any railroad or track, while such engine, car, motor or street car is in motion, switching or being switched.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
