An act authorizing the county commissioner in coun- County Surveyor. ties having a population of 150,000 and not over 200,000 feam hire. to provide team hire for the county surveyor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. In all counties having a population of not less than 150,000 inhabitants and not more than 200,000 inhabitants, the county commissioners may allow the county surveyor in said counties a sum not to exceed four hundred dollars (\$400) in each year for team hire to enable him to execute the duties of his office.

CHAPTER 54.

H. F. No. 424

An act to provide for the representation of Minnesota and an exhibition of its resources, products, progress and development at the Pan-American Exposition at Buffalo New York, during the year 1901, and to make an appropriation therefor.

Pan-Ameri-can Managers for Exposition at Buffalo.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That a board consisting of three (3) per- Governor appoints. sons, citizens of Minnesota, shall be appointed by the governor, to be known as the Board of Pan-American Managers for Minnesota, for the purposes in this act prescribed. Any member of said board may be removed by the governor at any time, and any vacancy in said board occuring, at any time, shall be filled by the governor.

Said board shall meet at such time and place as may be fixed by the governor, and organize by the election of a president, vice president and secretary. Said board shall have power to make such rules, regulations and by-laws, for its own government, as it may deem necessary and expedient, and as will not conflict with the rules and regulations of said Pan-American Exposition.

The members of said board shall receive no compensation for their services and their reimbursement for personal expenses shall be limited to an amount not exceeding three hundred (300) dollars for each of them.
