In Act to fix the compensation of senators and representatives of the legislature of the State of Minnesota and its presiding officers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Compensation.—Section 1. After the period for which the members of the existing house of representatives have been elected, the compensation of senators and representatives of the legislature of the State of Minnesota shall be five hundred dollars per year for the time for which they are elected, to be paid in the manner now provided by law, two hundred and fifty dollars thereof to be paid on the first day of February, and two hundred and fifty dollars on the fifteenth day of March, of each year.

Mileage.—Sec. 2. The compensation herein provided for shall be in full for all services which are required to be performed by senators and representatives, whether rendered during the session of the legislature or subsequent to the adjournment thereof; *provided*, that nothing in this act shall affect the compensation of senators and representatives for mileage in going to and returning from the session of the legislature.

Additional salary.—Sec. 3. The president of the senate and speaker of the house shall receive, in addition to the amounts specified in section one of this act, the sum of five (5) dollars each per day during any session of the legislature.

Sec. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
