

Sec. 193. **Reasonable time, what constitutes.**—In determining what is a “reasonable time” or an “unreasonable time,” regard is to be had to the nature of the instrument, the usage of trade or business (if any) with respect to such instruments, and the facts of the particular case.

Sec. 194. **Time, how computed—When last day falls on holiday.**—Where the day, or the last day, for doing any act herein required or permitted to be done falls on Sunday or on a holiday, the act may be done on the next succeeding secular or business day.

Sec. 195. **Application of act.**—The provisions of this act do not apply to negotiable instruments made and delivered prior to the taking effect hereof, nor shall they be construed as modifying, repealing or superseding any of the terms and provisions of Section 2747, Revised Laws, 1905.

Sec. 196. **Cases not provided for in act.**—In any case not provided for in this act the rules of (law and equity including) the law merchant shall govern.

Sec. 197. **Repeals.**—All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 198. **Time when act takes effect.**—This act shall take effect on the first day of July, 1913.

CHAPTER 273—S. F. No. 323.

An Act appropriating money for roads, fire lines and trails in, and for the care and improvement of, Burntside state forest.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **\$5,000 for Burntside state forest.**—There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for roads, fire lines and trails in, and for the care and improvement of, Burntside state forest, the sum of \$2,500.00, available for the year ending July 31, 1914, and the sum of \$2,500.00, available for the year ending July 31, 1915.
