CHAPTER 51-H. F. No. 164.

An Act to prevent fraudulent advertising.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Fraudulent statements in advertising prohibited. -Any person, firm, corporation or association who, with intent to sell or in any wise dispose of merchandise, securities, service, or anything offered by such person, firm, corporation or association, directly or indirectly, to the public, for sale or distribution, or with intent to increase the consumption thereof, or to induce the public in any manner to enter into any obligation relating thereto, or to acquire title thereto, or any interest therein, makes, publishes, disseminates, circulates, or places before the public, or causes, directly or indirectly, to be made, published, disseminated, circulated, or placed before the public, in this State, in a newspaper or other publication, or in the form of a book, notice, hand-bill, poster, bill, label, circular, pamphlet or letter, or in any other way, an advertisement of any sort regarding merchandise, securities, service, or anything so offered to the public, which advertisement contains any assertion, representation or statement of fact which is untrue, deceptive or misleading, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

CHAPTER 52-H. F. No. 168.

An Act fixing the time of holding the general terms of the district court of the Thirteenth (13th) Judicial District of the State of Minnesota.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. General terms of court in Thirteenth Judicial District.—The general terms of the district court shall be held each year in the several counties constituting the Thirteenth (13th) Judicial District of the State of Minnesota at the time herein prescribed as follows:

Cottonwood county, the first Monday in June; second Mon-

day in November;

Murray county, first Monday in May and December; Nobles county, third Monday in February and October;

Pipestone county, second Tuesday in January; third Tuesday in May;

Rock county, third Tuesday in March and the last Tuesday

in September.

Sec. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
