# STATE OF MINNESOTA

## EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

### PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Minnesota by an act has proposed an amendment to Section Sixteen (16) of Article Nine (9) of the Constitution, establishing the Road and Bridge Fund and authorizing the Legislature to levy an annual tax for the purpose of constructing and improving roads and bridges within this state; and

WHEREAS, It appears from the official canvass of the votes cast at the last general election November 5, 1912, for and against the aforesaid Constitutional Amendment, made in conformity with the law, that a majority of all the electors voting at such election upon said amendment voted for its adoption;

Now, THEREFORE, I, Adolph O. Eberhart, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the power vested in me, and in compliance with the aforesaid acts of the Legislature of this state do hereby publish and proclaim that the proposed amendment to Section Sixteen (16) of Article Nine (9) of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota has been ratified and adopted in the manner prescribed by the Constitution and laws of this state.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State to be hereto affixed this 3rd day of December, A. D. 1912.

## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, It appears from the official canvass of the votes cast at the last general election November 5, 1912, for and against the proposition "for increasing the gross earnings tax of railroad companies from four (4) to five (5) per cent, and providing for the payment of the gross earnings tax semi-annually" that a majority of all the electors voting at such election voted for the adoption of said proposition;
