CHAPTER 198-H. F. No. 1

An act relating to the hours for opening and closing the polls at special, primary and general elections and repealing of laws and parts of laws inconsistent herewith.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Opening and closing of poling places.—At all special, primary and general elections hereafter held in this state the polls shall open at the hours now provided by law except where the polls now open at 6:00 A. M. the time hereafter shall be 6:30 A. M. and in all cases shall remain open until 8:00 P. M.

Sec. 2. All laws and parts of laws inconsistent herewith are repealed.

CHAPTER 199-S. F. No. 296

An act relating to the powers of governing body of any town, city or village.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Powers of governing body of town, city or village.—In addition to all other powers now or hereafter by law conferred upon the governing body of any town, city or village, authority is hereby given to receive and accept for their town, city or village real or personal property, encumbered or unencumbered by gift, devise, conveyance or otherwise, from any person whose care, support, treatment or maintenance in whole or in part, under the laws relating to poor relief, is or may be chargeable to, furnished or provided by such town, city or village, and to hold or dispose of the same the benefit of such town, city or village, as provided by law in the case of other property belonging to such town, city or village, and the payment and discharge of any lien or encumbrances upon any such property is authorized when such governing body determines that such payment is advisable and for the best interests of such town, city or village.
