

Sec. 3. **Construction.**—Nothing in this Act shall be construed as repealing any statute permitting the spearing of fish without the use of artificial lights.

Sec. 4. **Statutes repealed.**—Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 5574, as amended by Laws 1931, Chapter 323, Section 2, and any other section or parts of sections inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Sec. 5. **Violation a misdemeanor.**—Violation hereof shall constitute a misdemeanor.

CHAPTER 50—S. F. No. 236

*An act authorizing the construction of sidewalks by certain Consolidated School Districts and Villages in such School Districts.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. **Consolidated school district may build sidewalks in certain cases.**—That the governing board of any consolidated school district which now or hereafter includes within its limits two villages, may appropriate and expend moneys to build or assist in building a sidewalk or sidewalks for the use of pupils and the general public, connecting with sidewalks in said villages and leading to the school house.

Sec. 2. **Village council may appropriate money therefor.**—That the village council of any such village may likewise appropriate money for the same purpose or to assist the school district.

CHAPTER 51—S. F. No. 464

*An act to amend Laws 1931, Chapter 285, relating to the time of holding the general terms of the District Court in the Fourteenth Judicial District of the State of Minnesota.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. **Terms of District Court in Fourteenth Judicial District.**—Laws, 1931, Chapter 285, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 1. The general terms of the District Court in the several counties constituting the Fourteenth Judicial District of the State of Minnesota shall be held, each year, at the times herein prescribed as follows:

Pennington County: On the *fourth Monday in February* and the *first Monday in October*.

Mahnomen County: On the fourth Monday in May.

Kittson County: On the fourth Monday in March, and the second Monday in November.

Roseau County: On the second Monday in April, and the fourth Monday in October.

Marshall County: On the first Monday in May, and the fourth Monday in November.

Norman County: On the third Monday in May, and the fourth Monday in October.

Polk County: On the first Monday in June, and the first Monday after the first day of January.

Red Lake County: On the second Monday in April, and the second Monday in October.

Sec. 2. **Inconsistent acts repealed.**—All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. **Effective April 1, 1933.**—This act shall take effect from and after *April 1, 1933.*"

#### CHAPTER 52—S. F. No. 550

*An act to amend Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 3659, as amended by Laws 1931, Chapter 269, relating to township mutual fire insurance companies.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Limitations of company.**—That Mason's Minnesota States of 1927, Section 3659, be amended to read as follows:

"3659. No township mutual fire insurance company heretofore organized, and no company organized pursuant to this act shall insure any property outside of the limits of the town or towns in which such company is authorized by its certificate or articles of incorporation to transact business, except personal property temporarily outside of such authorized territory and, except as herein-
