## CHAPTER 13—H. F. No. 32

An act to legalize certain proceedings heretofore taken for the issuance of bonds in cities of the fourth class for the construction of an intercepting sewer and primary treatment plant for sewage and authorizing the completion of such proceedings and the issuance of sewer bonds and legalizing such bonds.

'Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Certain proceedings and bonds legalized.—In all cases, where a city, of the fourth class has heretofore, taken proceedings for the issuance of bonds for the construction of an intercepting sewer and primary treatment plant for sewage and the question of wissuing such bonds, was, submitted to and approved, by the voters of such city at an election held for that purpose, such proceedings are hereby legalized and declared to be valid and of full force and effect notwithstanding any defects in such proceedings or in the maturities of the bonds and the council of any such city is hereby authorized to complete the proceedings for the issuance of such sewer bonds; provided, that, such bonds shall be payable serially in installments from six to twenty years from their date and that prior, to the issuance of such bonds the council of such city shall levy a tax for the payment thereof in the manner-prescribed. by Laws 1927, Chapter 131, Section 5.

Sec. 2. This Act shall not affect any bonds the validity of which is questioned in any litigation now pending.
