

CHAPTER 8—H. F. No. 12

An act to legalize conveyances of real property heretofore made, in which the acknowledgment of the grantors to the execution of said deed has been taken by one of the grantees in said deed, said grantee being a proper officer, duly authorized to take acknowledgments under the Laws of this State.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Certain conveyances legalized.**—That all conveyance of real property heretofore made in the year 1928 in which the acknowledgment of the grantors to the execution of said deed has been taken by one of the grantees in said deed, said grantee being a proper officer duly authorized to take acknowledgments under the laws of this state, shall be in all respects legal and valid as fully as though all the provisions of law in regard to said acknowledgment had been fully complied with, provided, that the provisions of this Act shall not apply to any action or proceeding now pending in any court in this state.

CHAPTER 9—H. F. No. 14

An act authorizing the Governor to convey to the Minneopa Cemetery Association that part of Minneopa State Park therein described.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Governor authorized to execute deed.**—The Governor of the State of Minnesota is hereby authorized and directed to execute a deed conveying from the State to Minneopa Cemetery Association the following described land now a portion of Minneopa State Park:

: : Beginning at a corner that is marked by an iron pipe set in
: concrete, on the boundary line between Minneopa State Park
: and the Minneopa Cemetery Grounds, seven hundred (700)
: feet East and Two Hundred Fifty (250) feet Southwesterly

of the Northwest corner of Section Twenty-one (21), Township One Hundred and Eight (108) North of Range Twenty-seven (27) West, in Blue Earth County, State of Minnesota, thence Sixty-five (65) feet West, thence South to the Northernly line of the Chicago, St. Paul, Minneapolis, and Omaha Railroad Right of Way, thence Easterly along said Northernly line of said right of way Twelve (12) feet, thence Northeasterly to the place of beginning, and containing approximately Thirty-one hundredths (.31) acres.

CHAPTER 10—H. F. No. 19

An act to amend Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927, Section 3165, as amended by Chapter 198 of the Laws of 1933, relating to the care of the poor under county system.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Supervisor of poor.**—That Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927, Section 3165 as amended by Chapter 198, Laws of 1933, be, and the same herein is amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. In Counties having the County System, the members of the County Board shall be supervisors of the Poor; provided that in counties where the board has employed and appointed an Overseer of Poor, the County Board may by resolution confer full authority for granting temporary relief to the poor on the Overseer of and Poor or such other person as may be appointed by them, and in such cases the Overseer or such other person so appointed shall be the only authorized agent of the county to incur expenses for relief of the Poor. In case a person other than the Overseer of the Poor is appointed for said purpose, he shall be designated as the County Poor Relief Agent and shall hold his office during the pleasure of the County Board and his compensation shall be fixed by the Board annually. The board may establish and maintain a poorhouse for the reception and support of poor persons chargeable on the county, and also, if it shall deem best, a poor farm or work house, or both, for the employment of the poor therein.
