Power and Building Commission to pay and allow compensation hereunder, shall be by resolution adopted by majority vote of the members of said Commission, other than the member or members to be compensated.

Sec. 2. Must be authoried by village council.—A resolution of the Village Council of such village, passed by a four-fifths vote of the members thereof, authorizing and consenting to the payment of the compensation above described, shall also be necessary before any payments shall be nade under this Act.

CHAPTER 19-S. F. No. 30

An act to create a revolving fund in the office of the State Treasurer and to appropriate twenty thousand dollars (\$\frac{2}{2}\text{0}\$,-000.00) for the operation of the same.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. State Treasurer's revolving fund created.— That a revolving fund of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.0)) be created, to be kept in the State Treasurer's office for the purpose of cashing drafts, checks, and state warrants, which shall be cleared from day to day in the usual manner.
- Sec. 2. Appropriations.—There is hereby appropriated, the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) from the revenue fund of the State, not otherwise appropriated, and the State Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to issue a state warrant on the state revenue fund, payable to the State Treasurer, in the amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) and the State Treasurer is authorized and directed to procure cash on said warrant for the purpose of carrying out the use thereof as above outlined. The State Treasurer shall at all times be liable to the State under his bond for the full amount of said \$20,000.00.

An act relating to the manner of taking certain fish within certain localities and to licenses therefor.
