which sale is made. Every such license shall expire May 1st, next after its issue; shall be given only to a person owning or leasing the vehicle or place from which sales are to be made, and shall not be transferred. Each license shall be numbered and shall contain the name, residence and place of business of the licensee, the names of all employees authorized to act thereunder, and the number of vehicles and places to be used. The name and number of the license shall be plainly inscribed on both sides of each vehicle in use for the purpose aforesaid, and the license shall be conspicuously posted in each place where such milk or cream is sold, and the making of every sale from the vehicle not so inscribed or from a place where such license is not so posted, shall be deemed the commission of a misdemeanor. Provided that any person may sell or peddle the products of the farm or garden occupied and cultivated by him without obtaining a license therefor. And provided that no permit, inspection, or other authorization shall be required of such person unless the cost thereof is paid by the municipality, agency or board reauiring the same."

CHAPTER 218-H. F. No. 547

An act fixing the salary of the sheriff in any county in this state which now has or may hereafter have a population of more than 150,000 inhabitants and an area of more than 5,000 square miles, and repealing all inconsistent acts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Salary of sheriff in certain counties.—That in any county in this State which now has or may hereafter have a population of more than 150,000 inhabitants and an area of more than 5,000 square miles, the sheriff shall receive an annual salary of \$5,000.00, payable in the same manner as the salaries of other county officers are paid.

Sec. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
