

CHAPTER 22—H. F. No. 688

An act providing for the exemption of building and loan associations, credit unions, and licensed pawnbrokers from the provisions of Laws 1939, Chapter 12.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Limitations of act.—The provisions of Laws 1939, Chapter 12, shall not apply to any person, as defined by said chapter, doing business under and as permitted by any law of this state or of the United States relating to building and loan associations, credit unions, or licensed pawnbrokers.

CHAPTER 23—H. F. No. 62

An act relating to size, weight, and load upon highways; and to amend the 1938 Supplement to Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 2720-269, Subdivision (b), and Section 2720-270.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Application of act.—The 1938 Supplement to Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 2720-269, Subdivision (b), is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“2720-269.

(b) The provisions of this article governing size, weight, and load shall not apply to fire apparatus, or to implements of husbandry temporarily moved upon a highway, or to loads of loose hay or corn stalks if transported by a horse-drawn vehicle or drawn by a farm tractor, or to a vehicle operated under the terms of a special permit issued as herein provided.”

Sec. 2. Width of loads—forest products.—The 1938 Supplement to Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 2720-270, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
