CHAPTER 5—H. F. No. 511 [Not Coded]

An act relating to the Department of Highways and employees thereof and authorizing certain services to the Federal Government.

WHEREAS, the federal authorities have advised the state highway commissioner of Minnesota of an emergency in the State of South Dakota due to the terrific snowstorms encountered by the people of that state; and

WHEREAS, assistance is requested of the Minnesota state highway commissioner by way of equipment and men to assist the federal governmental authorities in the saving of life and property in the state so afflicted, and the State of Minnesota is promised reimbursement by the federal government in connection therewith; THEREFORE

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Highway commissioner, emergency duties. The highway commissioner of Minnesota is hereby authorized to use such equipment and such number of men as in his discretion can be properly furnished by him to assist the federal government in the above stated emergency, on condition that the state be reimbursed by the federal government for the use or loss of such equipment and the cost of operating such service.

Sec. 2. Employees, rights of. All state employees so furnished shall be entitled to all rights under all applicable laws of the State of Minnesota while so serving.
