

time of the filing of the first paper therein. Such law library fees shall be costs in the case and taxable as such.

Subd. 3. After the filing of such certificate, it shall be the duty of the Clerk of the Probate Court in any such county to collect from the person filing in said court a petition for the administration of an estate or the probate of a will at the time of the filing of such petition the sum of one dollar as a law library fee, which fee shall be allowed as part of the cost of administration of any such estate provided, however, that such fee shall not be collected in any summary proceedings under M.S.A. Section 525.1.

Subd. 4. The failure to file the certificate of a majority of the judges of any such court shall not interfere with the collection of library fees for such purpose from the other courts named in this section.

Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 140.18, is amended to read:

140.18. Fees collected by clerk of district court, clerk of the probate court, and clerk of the municipal court deposited with county treasurer. The clerk of the district court, *the clerk of the Probate Court and the clerks of any municipal court in such counties* shall thereafter pay all the library fees collected by him or them, pursuant to Section 140.06, to the treasurer of the county, who is hereby authorized to disburse the same and any other moneys belonging to the library, upon the order of the trustees, to pay the necessary expenses of the library.

CHAPTER 569—S. F. No. 1426

An act authorizing the commissioner of administration to sell and the governor to convey certain lands owned by the State of Minnesota situate in St. Louis County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. State lands conveyed to Village of Hibbing. The commissioner of administration is authorized to sell and the governor to convey to the highest bidder the following described real property situate in the Village of Hibbing, St. Louis County, Minnesota, to-wit:

Lots Nineteen (19) and Twenty (20), in Block Three (3), of Pillsbury Addition to Hibbing, according to the plat of said addition of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of said county, with all the improvements thereon; except all minerals and ores of every kind that may exist upon, in or under said premises, and subject to the right of the prior owners thereof to enter upon said premises to mine and remove said minerals and ores reserved in any deed or grant of said lands on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said county, reserving to the state, however, the right to reject any and all bids.

The commissioner may, in his discretion, divide said real property into parcels and sell each parcel to the highest bidder.

CHAPTER 570—S. F. No. 1511

An act relating to compensation of school board members in certain common school districts; amending Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 123.17.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 123.17, is amended to read:

123.17. Compensation of school district officers. In all common school districts composed of ten or more townships each member of the school board in such districts shall receive as annual compensation for his services as a member of such board the amounts herein stated:

\$200 a year where such district contains 30 public schools;
\$400 a year where such district contains 31 public schools but
