

CHAPTER 631—S. F. No. 1189

[Coded as Section 101.41]

An act relating to the seasons for the taking of fish, and amending Laws 1949, Chapter 150, Section 33, Subdivision 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1949, Chapter 150, Section 33, Subdivision 2, is amended to read as follows:

[101.41]Fish, season and limits. Subd. 2. Except as otherwise provided, the following fish may be taken only by angling with a single line, transported and possessed, subject to all other provisions of this act, between the dates set opposite each species, and the number which may be taken each day or which may be possessed at any one time, subject to the aggregate limits imposed by subdivision 3, shall be as prescribed in the following table:
